

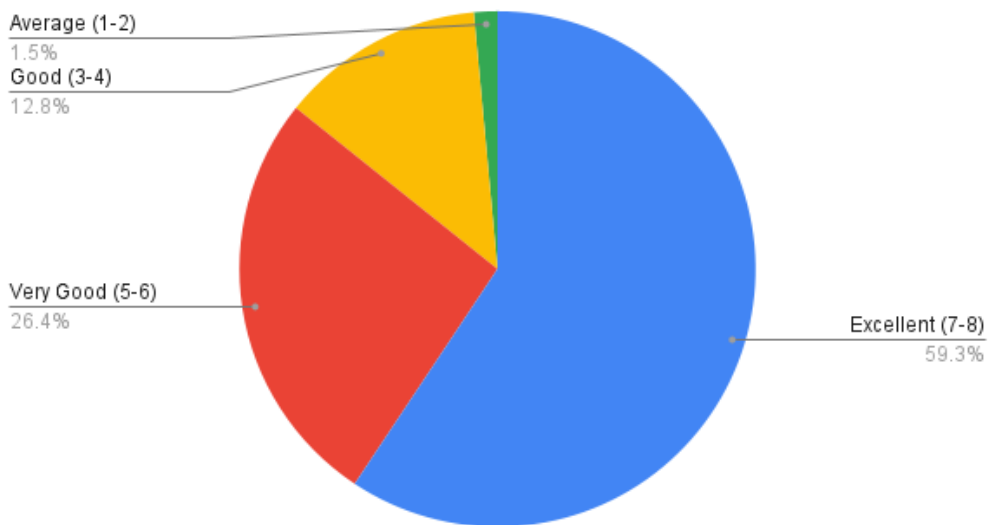

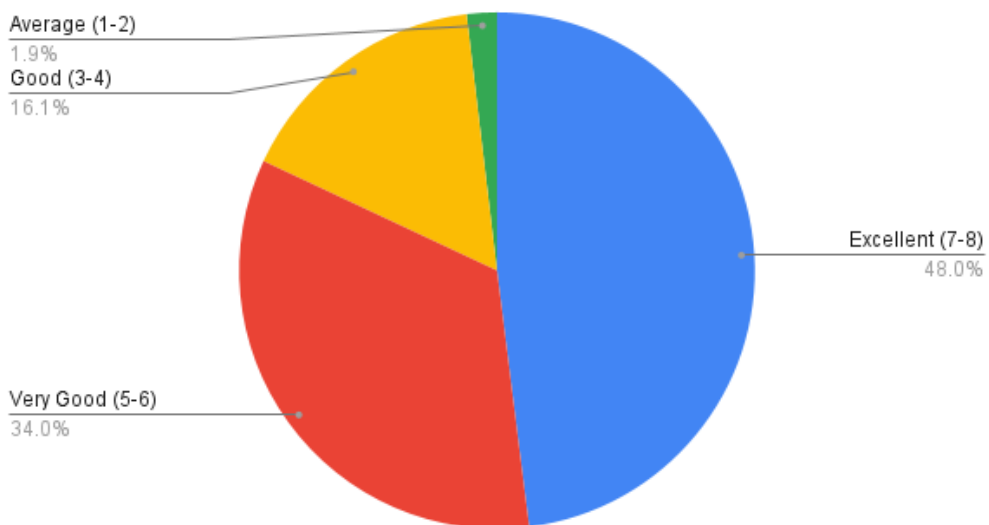
1) Parameter: Course Content

Count of Parameter [Course content]



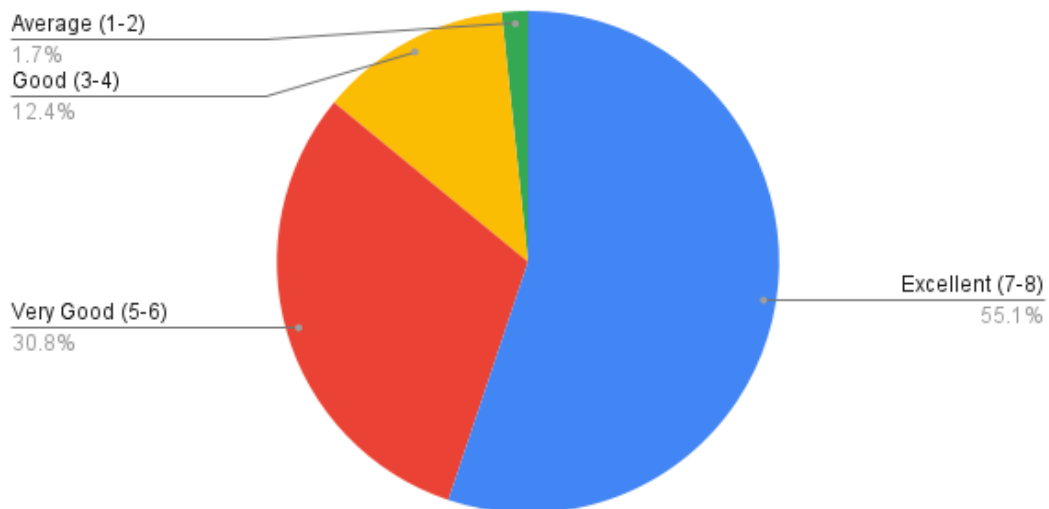
2) Parameter: Extent of Course Objective Achieved

Count of Parameter [Extent of course objective achieved]



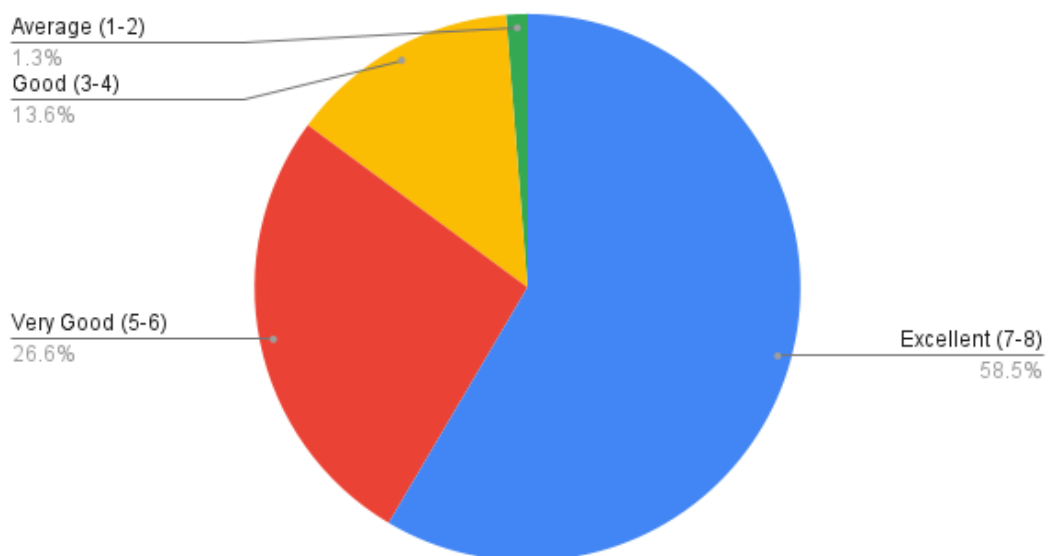
3) Learning Value (in terms of Knowledge, Concepts, Manual and Analytical Skills and Broadening Perspective)

Count of Parameter [Learning value (in terms of knowledge, concepts, manual & analytical skills and broadening]

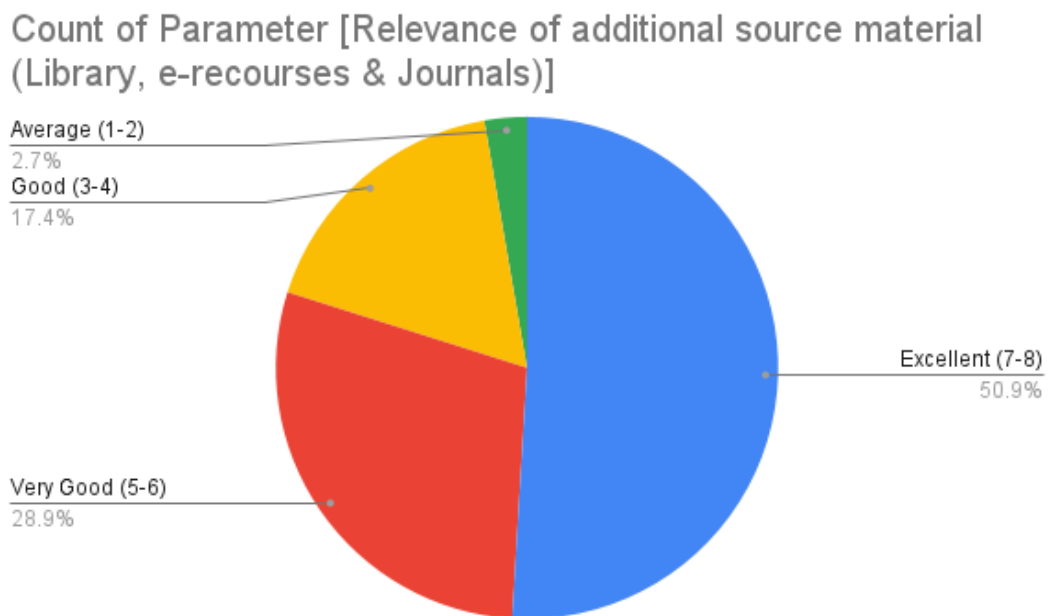


4) Parameter: Clarity and Relevance of Syllabus

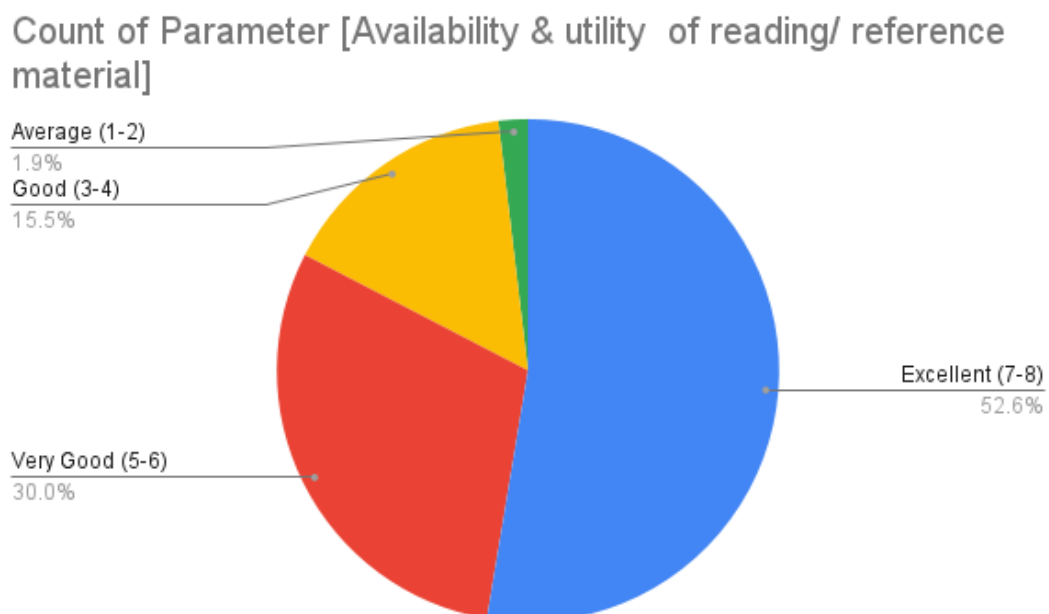
Count of Parameter [Clarity and relevance of syllabus]



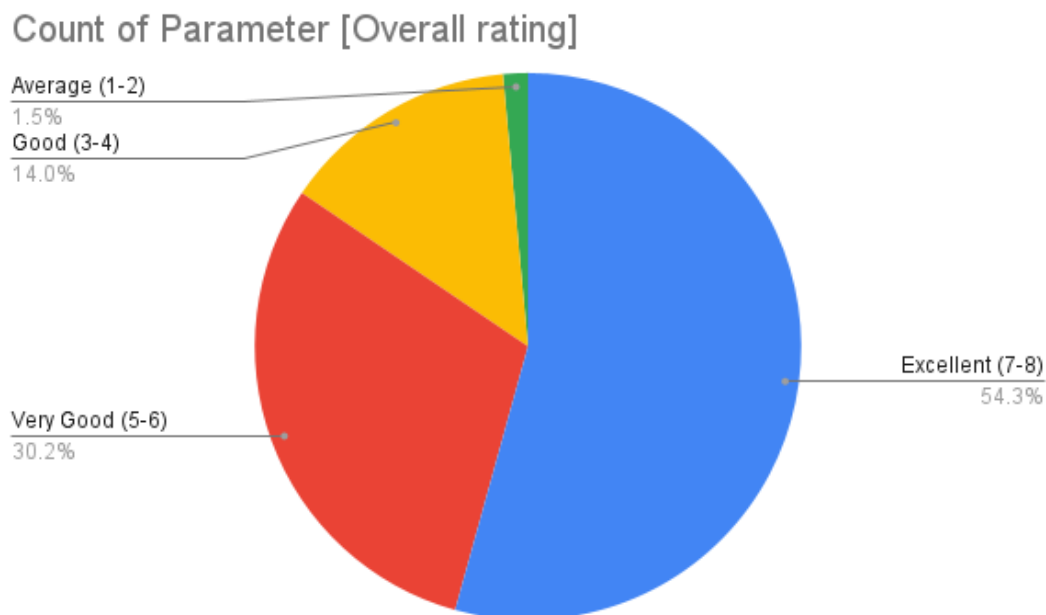

B) Teacher's Feedback
